Experimenting system modelling for Science and Policy integration in the coastal zone

SPICOSA, Science and Policy Integration for COastal System Assessment, is an Integrated Programme under the 6th Framework Programme (www.spicosa.eu). It has developed a System Approach Framework for integrated modelling and tested it in 18 Study Site Applications (SSA) for different policy issues related to environmental or resources management in European coastal zones. 7 cases are presented in a workshop on the 22nd for discussion of lessons learned.
