## Experimenting system modelling for Science and Policy integration in the coastal zone

**SPICOSA**, Science and Policy Integration for COastal System Assessment, is an Integrated Programme under the 6<sup>th</sup> Framework Programmme (www.spicosa.eu). It has developed a System Approach Framework for integrated modelling and tested it in 18 Study Site Applications (SSA) for different policy issues related to environmental or resources management in European coastal zones. 7 cases are presented in a workshop on the 22<sup>nd</sup> for discussion of lessons learned. The work done in the 18 Study Sites is presented with posters.
